Heavy equipment machines normally work in extreme surroundings and are put under great strain on a regular basis. Thus, there are numerous heavy machine jobs available in repair and maintenance. Operators of heavy machines are highly trained workers who can troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy equipment on site or in a workshop. Mechanics should be available to transport their tools to a job site and perform maintenance and repair in a variety of surroundings.

It might be possible for delivery drivers to get work with simply a CDL, even though for some jobs, certain endorsements may be needed.
