Zoom Boom Ticket Casa Grande - Zoom Boom Training focuses on correctly training potential operators on variable reach forklifts. The training goals consist of gaining the knowledge of the equipments physics and to be able to define the responsibilities of the operator. This course follows North American safety standards for lift trucks. Zoom boom training and certification is accessible at our site or at the company's location, provided there are a minimum number of trainees. Certification given upon successful completion is good for three years.

A telescopic handler (likewise called a telehandler) is similar in some ways to both a crane and a forklift. It is a useful machine designed with a telescopic boom that can lift upwards and extend forward. Various attachments can be fitted on the end of the boom, like for example pallet forks, bucket, lift table or muck grab. It is popular in agriculture and industry settings.

Telehandlers are most usually used with the fork attachment to transport loads. The units have the advantage that they could get to places not accessible to regular forklifts. Telehandlers are capable of removing palletized loads from inside a trailer and putting them on places that are high like for instance rooftops. For certain applications, they could be a lot more efficient and practical compared to a crane.

When lifting heavy loads, the telehandler may experience some unsteadiness. As the boom is extended very far with a load, the machinery would become more unstable. Counterweights in the rear help, but don't solve the problem. When the working radius increases, the lifting capacity quickly decreases. Several equipment come with front outriggers which extend the lifting capacity when the equipment is stationary.
