Forklift Training Guidelines

It is essential that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety rules are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whatever question indicates a procedural weakness which can lead to damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is visibly clear stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) Are mirrors for drivers and pedestrians provided at blind spots?
- 6) Are changes to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected workers?
- 7) Are lift truck tires suitable for use on all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being utilized?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) The maintenance schedule of the forklift is being followed?
- 11) Are annual checks of the forklift being done?
- 12) Is the forklift right for the required job?
- 13) Does forklift has a readable load chart?
- 14) Do all operators understand how to read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work right?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted right?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted right?
- 19) Have all forklift operators acquired certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Do operators understand their responsibilities to report any machine damage and lift truck accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed every day prior to the machine being used?
